We are offering a workshop to parents to support literacy development and to give you an understanding of how we teach literacy at Woodside. For **Reception** Parents and **new parents** throughout the school we have planned a "Reading Information" evening on Wednesday 20th September starting at 7pm in the school hall.


As many of you are aware we teach **phonics** using the "Read, Write, Inc." scheme of work. We teach **reading** by using a combination of this scheme and other colour coded reading books alongside various methods of small group and whole class teaching. It is vital that children have access to many sources of reading materials in order to develop all the skills required for reading including fluency and comprehension.

You are welcome to choose as many reading books from the coloured boxes as you wish. Your child's teacher will advise you on the appropriate coloured box to choose books from.

Reminders regarding food and medicine

If your child requires medicine of some description, we can administer this at school but it would need to be prescribed by the doctor and in its original container with the prescription label on it.

Please can I remind you that we are a nut free school and that sweets, chocolate and fizzy drinks are not permitted in lunch boxes either.

Chocolate biscuits are acceptable.

Safeguarding

It is the responsibility of the staff in school to safeguard your children at all times. Your cooperation in this is vital. We do need to know who your child is going home with. If there is a regular routine to this, please put a copy in the "going home book" in each classroom.

This can be a challenge for parents who work shifts; for those parents please inform the class teacher via either the "going home" book or the "home/school" sharing book. For children's well-being, they need to know who is collecting them at the end of each day as this can be an anxious time for them.

When bringing your child into school do not leave your child on the playground it is your responsibility to pass your child over to an adult in school.
