Research commissioned by the Department for Education shows missing school for even a day can mean a child is less likely to achieve good grades, which can have a damaging effect on their life chances. At Woodside our aim is to work with parents to ensure that all our pupils receive the most from their education and reach their full potential.

This is a reminder for all parents/carers that the law requires you to ensure that your child attends school regularly. The Government remains very clear that no child should miss school apart from in exceptional circumstances and schools must continue to take steps to reduce absence to support children's attainment.

If your child is absent from school on any day you must notify school early. Please phone the office before 9.30am otherwise, your child's attendance will be marked as unauthorised.

Holidays in term time will <u>not</u> be authorised but we do still need notification 2 weeks in advance.
