Summer Term at Woodside


Welcome back to the start of the Summer Term! We hope you all had a good rest over Easter and ready for the thrilling term ahead.

Just a reminder of safety in the sun

We saw some rising temperatures last week - A taste of summer!

In order to keep the children safe when the temperature rises we ask you to make sure the children have the following things available in school:

A water bottle with fresh <u>water</u> every day, a sun hat and an application of sun cream before your child comes to school. We are unable to apply sun cream in school. If your child has fair skin it would be advisable to apply a high factor sun cream which would last for the whole school day.
