In addition, all children will have received a £1 book token to be used in participating book shops.

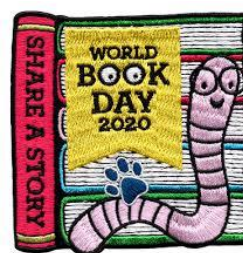
## Year 1 Dance Show

### Hand cream and soap in school

The soap we use is a moisturising anti-bacterial handwash that comes with the expected COSHH reports that we have to have in school. The children are being encouraged to wash their hands regularly, even more than the normal due to the current situation with the Coronavirus. This in turn is having a knock-on effect with children suffering with chapped hands. We have always stipulated creams cannot be brought in to school due to allergies that people suffer, and this must still be the case. Lots of creams contain ingredients that is intolerant for some people so we really can't have these in school.
