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## Summer 3.1

Subject	Coverage
Maths	Statistics, measurements, shape, fractions
English: Reading	Continue reading at appropriate level for individuals using the Ruth Miskin reading scheme or free reading selection. Comprehension activities to improve understanding of inference, be able to ask and answer questions about texts and make predictions based on what's read.
English: Writing	Stories, fiction and non-fiction, with a focus on conjunctions and dialogue
Phonics	Spellings
English: Grammar	Contractions, possessive apostrophes, homophones and near homophones.
Science	Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants and what they need to grow and stay healthy.
Art	Flower art
Design & Technology	Consider what insects need to survive, design a bug hotel and create in grounds of school.
Computing	Creating a powerpoint presentation-opening, saving, typing and experimenting with fonts.
PE	Team games
RE	Why do people have different views about the ideas of God?
PHSE	Rights and responsibilities
Music	Investigating music through "The Friendship Song"
