Dear Parents and Guardians,

Just before we break up for the Easter holidays, I would like to update you all on several items.

Travel

We continue to make progress with the great challenge of ensuring that the community travels to school safely.

Firstly, thank you to all who participated so actively in the recent Sustrans Big Walk and Wheel. It has a huge impact when families are able to travel to school without the use of a car. Please remember, if you are driving, by far the most convenient and safest place to park is the village hall at the back of the school. There are always spaces and it is just a short walk away along the enclosed path from Back Lane.

We have also recently been seeking the support of PC Stuart Banard in effort to encourage safer driving around school. PC Banard has spent some time outside the front of school monitoring travel. Thankfully, no fines have needed to be issued for improperly stopping or parking on the yellow zig-zags. We continue to monitor this and are thankful for all those who respect this crucial safety measure.

Apologies, they have taken a little while to get going, but we have set up a permit system for on-site parking. These are only for a very few families who need the use of the school car park for special circumstances. COVID-19

It has been a very challenging half-term, keeping the school running with lots of staff absence to manage, amid rising cases. Thankfully, positive cases have reduced significantly this week. Most importantly, all those who have tested positive have recovered well.

I am very sorry for all the disruption caused and sorry if, while staffing has been limited, support for your children has been impacted. We hope to get back to normal after the break but thank you for your patience and understanding.

There have been more changes to national guidance. The government set out the <u>next steps for living with COVID-19</u> in England. Free COVID-19 tests will continue to be available for specific groups, including eligible patients and NHS staff, once the universal testing offer ends today.

Updated guidance advises the following:

- Adults with the symptoms of a respiratory infection, and who have a high temperature or feel unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature
- Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend
- Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days
